

**Key points to Chrysler Group LLC  
2010 Annual Enrollment  
for Pre-age 65 and Post-age 65  
Salaried Retirees and Surviving Spouses**

**Pre-age 65**

- Enrollment begins November 4<sup>th</sup> – online only
  - Phone Enrollment begins November 9<sup>th</sup>
  - Enrollment deadline is November 18<sup>th</sup>
  - Review enrollment kits mailed to your address of record
- Company continues to provide
  - Comprehensive medical benefits
  - Prescription drug benefits
  - Dental & vision benefits
- Premiums continue to be based on percentage of gross pension income
- Open election year for dental and vision
  - You can opt in or out of coverage
  - Elections will remain in place for two (2) years
- If you do not make elections your previously elected coverages will carry over
- New federal regulations require Social Security Numbers for any dependents enrolled in health care coverage

**Post-age 65**

- Company continues to provide contributions to Health Care Retiree Account (HRA)
  - Chrysler will contribute up to \$1,860 for retirees and surviving spouses
  - Chrysler will contribute up to \$1,750 for spouses and domestic partners
  - Funds will be made available January 2010
- Medicare enrollment period is from November 15 - December 31, 2009
- Review HRA News mailed to your address of record
- The Hartford Medicare Supplemental plan administered by NEBCO will no longer be offered; current enrollees will be automatically enrolled in United American unless they choose a new plan for 2010
